# Nick Marshall

*2020 Australian of the Year -Local Hero- QLD & Albatross Nipper's Founder*

2020 will forever be remembered as the season of isolation and that was never really able to be completed. But for me personally it was a very special year, it was the year I was both lucky and privileged to win the Australian of the Year- Local Hero for Queensland. This was an incredibly special moment for me personally as well as all the amazing surf lifesaving volunteers that have helped to make the Albatross Nippers, and inclusive communities a success. But it was not lost on me that when I was 7 years of age, the same age as my eldest Nobby's nipper daughter, my teacher sat both my parents and I down to tell us that I was special. Sadly she didn't mean special in the way as a parent you'd like to hear from your grade 2 teacher. In fact she didn't use the term special at all, but instead a derogatory term nowadays to describe my inability to learn, a word that said I was basically different. Further to this she suggested that I find another school away from mainstream schooling, away from my friends. A school where I would be surrounded by people more like me, people who were different.

Now 30 years on with a fancy title like Assistant Professor, and a Bachelor and Masters Degree in Physiotherapy as well as a number of research papers published it's safe to say she probably got the diagnosis wrong. That's fine, it's ok to be wrong and she was not an evil or malicious person at all, but more a product of a generation that sought to segregate and isolate those who were seen as different.

They say it takes a village to raise a child, and nobody needs that village more than a family of a child with special needs. In my generation and those before me, the village failed these families because as we saw in my personal experience, they sought to isolate and segregate those that were different. We didn't embrace difference, but our youth today do. They're the greatest 'includers' and engagers of people with difference we've ever seen.

When I started the Albatross Nippers, a completely inclusive nipper program that runs within the standard nipper program at Nobby's Beach Surf Lifesaving Club I had no idea of the enormous impact it would make not just on those families and their children with special needs but the greater Gold Coast community. It allowed improved access to the beaches and opened up a whole new world for these families to suddenly experience and explore like any family. It meant these previously isolated families were able to join the surf club, be welcomed in the wider surf lifesaving family and most importantly re-engage with the local community.

One of the ways we were able to achieve this so well was that in the inclusive nipper program the vast majority of our volunteers are our youth, a generation that embraces difference, a generation that doesn't need a manual, or an app, or set of rules and guidelines as to how to communicate and engage with difference, to them it comes naturally. I constantly tell people, that my two daughters don't go to school and kindy with "that kid with down Syndrome, or that kid with cerebral palsy" like I did. They go to school and kindy, with Marcus and Lilly and it's the ease with which they can include and engage with people who our society feels are different that's helping to better educate and demonstrate to our generation what true inclusion looks like. If we can continue to grow inclusive programs and continue to promote more inclusion within our surf clubs then I truly believe we will be one step closer to creating that "village" that can better raise everyone's children.

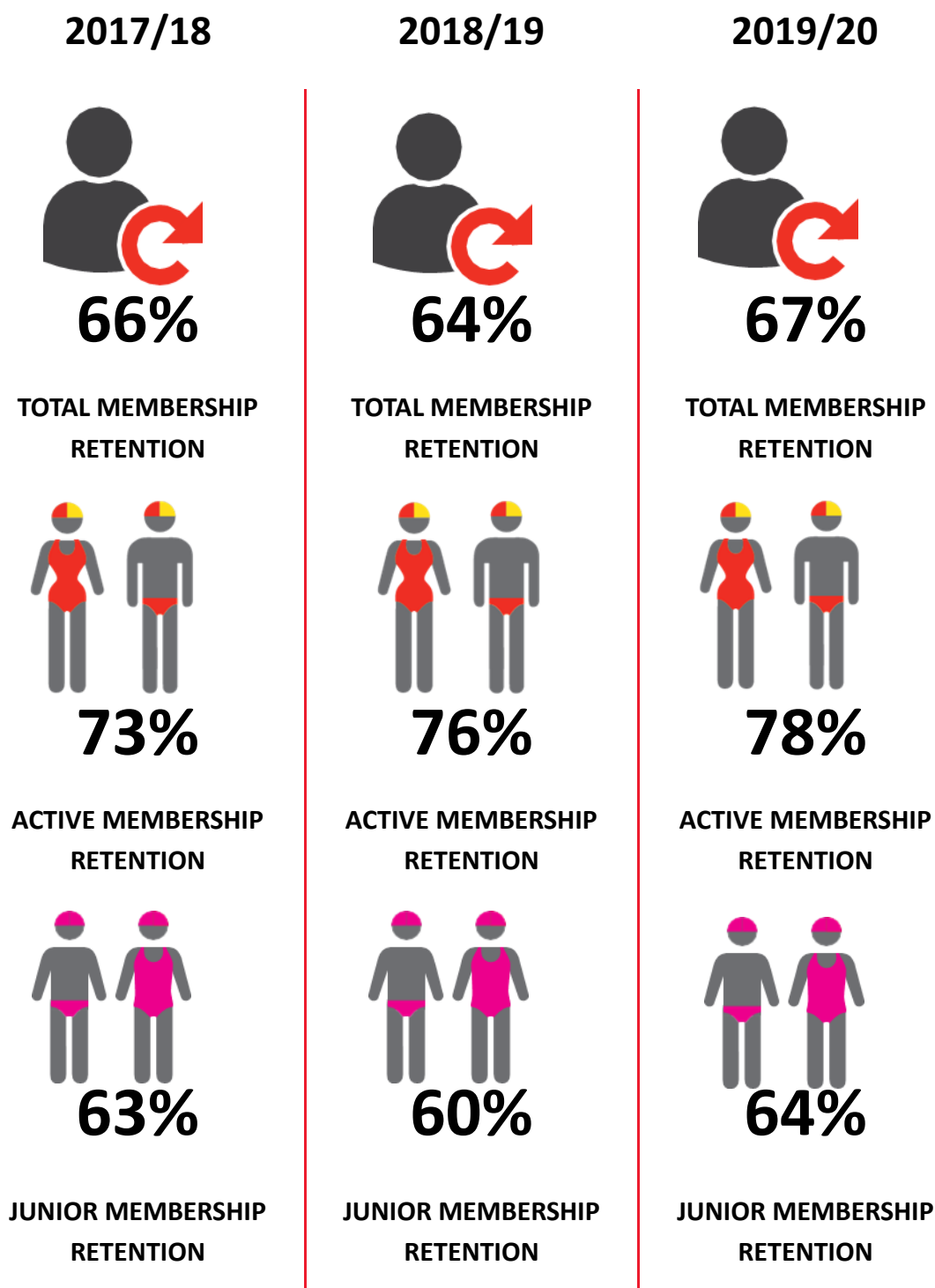

Even with the challenges we all faced with the Covid-19 pandemic our clubs and their members continued to provide lifesaving services to the community and go about their business keeping the public safe and upskilling our members.

This report contains the impressive efforts, statistics and results of vigilance and service provided year round to the community and visitors to our beautiful South Coast Branch Beaches. I would like to sincerely thank our club Presidents, Executives, Office Bearers and staff for the excellent work and commitment this season. All clubs are at the heart of our communities and the giving of precious time is truly appreciated. Also our Branch Executive, Officers, Advisors, Officials and Assessors who work tirelessly for the good of the South Coast Branch and the wellbeing of our clubs and members should be commended for their ongoing efforts.

The Branch is fortunate to have such a solid relationship with SLSQ and the support we are provided by the Gold Coast Regional Office is outstanding. A special thanks to the Gold Coast Regional Manager, Lachlan Sherrington and his wonderful team of Leah Campbell, Cathleen Edgar, Rebekah Austin, Nathan Fife and Matthew Palmer for their dedication to their respective roles and being accountable for delivering much needed support and advice to our clubs, members and Branch Executive.

One of the first undertakings of our Branch Committee this season was to undertake a survey of all of our clubs to learn more about their attitudes towards the service provision and standards of the Branch to ensure that we are providing the best possible outcomes for our clubs and members. It was pleasing, and a credit to past Presidents and Committees, that there was 100% engagement with the clubs, 100% stated that the Branch was relevant and 80% suggesting that the Branch was doing a good job. As a starting point for taking on the role of a President of the Branch I am pleased to start in such a positive position.

The Branch executive this season has taken on the projects of updating the Constitution and By-Laws as well as reviewing the Strategic plan for the Branch. There has been significant headway made on these tasks and I am delighted with the way the people involved in the reviews have thought about setting up the Branch for the future. Member Welfare has been at the forefront of the review and I look forward to receiving feedback from clubs to validate the Branches Committees investment into the Constitution review. Thank you to Richard, Evan and Ian for their time, skill and dedication to this work.

It was pleasing to see clubs so willingly adapt to new conditions and use flexibility and common sense to provide surveillance patrols during the COVID period. It was a challenging period for SLSQ decision makers and clubs to ensure the safety of the bathing public whilst also addressing social distancing protocols.

Our ability to pivot instantaneously to provide solutions for the safety of the public is commendable and the communication to ensure all clubs provided the same service levels around the state were impressive. The use of technology to communicate via electronic video conferencing was at first a challenge for many, however the medium became the norm and weekly club meetings via videoconference ensured a well connected Branch and clear instructions for all.

Although our season was somewhat cut short in terms of carnivals and events it does not diminish the outstanding work of all of our membership base in keeping our beaches safe. The role of a surf club in a community cannot be undervalued. Surf Clubs provide sport, employment pathways, Nationally Recognised Training, Friendships, community connection, safety for tourists, economic stimulus during our events all of which contribute to better safer communities. Being part of Surf Life Saving has given a real purpose to my own life and I whole heartedly believe in everything we do. I only hope that every new nipper that joins our movement can gain as much as I have out of their life long love of the surf and of keeping people safe on our beaches.

I would like to acknowledge the sustained support of Surf Life Saving Queensland, Surf Life Saving Australia, the Queensland Government, the Australian Government, the City OF Gold Coast and the Redland City Council, that ensure we are provided resources that help our clubs have the equipment and resources required to patrol our beaches.

Sustaining operations this season has been an unprecedented challenge and I thank everyone for their resilience, adaptability, commitment and support to me as President. It has been a privilege to serve this season as President and I wish everyone the best of health and wellbeing in these current times and every success for season 2020/21. Thank you to everyone for being a contributor to saving lives.

# Rescue of the Month

Congratulations to the following members that were nominated for rescue of the month this season:

## **Xavier Thompson and Michael Hill—Southport**

On the 3rd of November 2019, Patrol 5 had finished their patrolling duties for the day, pack up had been completed and members were heading to the Surf Club.

A father had entered the water to try and rescue his 10 year old son who was caught in a rip. As one of the Patrol Members was walking towards the Surf Club, a member of the public advised him that someone was in trouble down at the beach. The patrol member proceeded to grab a rescue board from the rack in the Club House and ran down to the beach and entered the water to rescue the father, meanwhile a member of the public assisted the son safely back to shore.

A second patrol member was alerted by a member of the public. He ran down to the beach to assist with the rescue, when he arrived the father had been rescued and was conscious on the beach. The father whom was a 40 year old male then collapsed, turned pale and became less and less responsive. An employee of the Surf Club had been alerted and he also came down to the beach to assist, he rang 000. The second patrolling member returned to the first aid room at the Club House to collect the oxygen and defibrillator, he returned to the beach and began to administer oxygen to the patient. Patrol Members administered oxygen and monitored the patient while they waited for the QAS to arrive. The other Patrol members were alerted and were stationed in the club car park to provide directions and guide QAS to the location of the casualty. On arrival, QAS officers began an assessment of the patient; patrol members briefed QAS on the condition of the patient. The patient had become increasingly pale, incoherent and his body temperature had dropped to 31.6 degrees. The patient began to vomit and QAS began administering drugs. The patient was assisted to the QAS vehicle and escorted off the beach by patrol members. Once of the beach patrol members assisted with transferring the patient to another QAS vehicle and then the patient was transported to Gold Coast University Hospital.

## **Carol Templeton—Southport**

On the 29th of February 2020, Carol who is a vital member of our Education Team here at Southport was taking part in the training of the new SRC/Bronze Members coming through our club. She was on her way down to the Southport Restaurant roughly around 7pm when she heard what she thought was two girls in trouble. This screaming was very high pitched and automatically Carol knew that these members of the public were in trouble.

She ran down to the top of the sand to see a better view, which was quite nearly impossible due to the sun having gone down and the night setting in. She could clearly see that these two boys were in desperate need of help. She ran back up to the Club Rooms to find the garage door was locked and with having seconds to spare before these boys went under she did not have time to find one of the Duty Managers to unlock the garage. She found her self in situation that no one should be faced with. Carol decided to rescue the two boys with the aid of no equipment. She ran back down to the waters edge and began the rescue of these two boys. Putting her own life at risk Carol managed to get both of the boys back to land safely.

The boys names were Lachlan who was 15 years of age and Daniel who was 17 years of age. These boys were very lucky to be going home to their family this night, because if it was not for Carol and her courageous efforts things could of ended a lot differently. From this incident we now have a Defibrillator and Rescue Tube sitting at the Reception of the Surf Club so that if a situation like this is to happen again we will have the correct resources to use to conduct a safe and efficient rescue.

## **Mia and Cooper Findlay—Burleigh Heads Mowbray Park**

On the 31st May 2020, Mia and Cooper performed their first Rescue at Burleigh Beach. The two noticed 2 swimmers in trouble out the front of the club. They were approximately 100m from the shore. Mia and Cooper had their boards with them and jumped into action and paddled out to support the swimmers in trouble until help from the Lifeguard arrived. 10 year old Mia and 12 year old Cooper responded to the incident immediately and used skills that they learnt through Nippers to support and rescue swimmers in trouble.

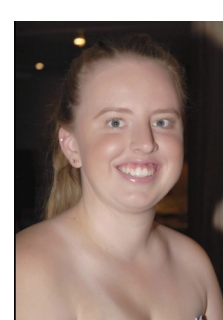

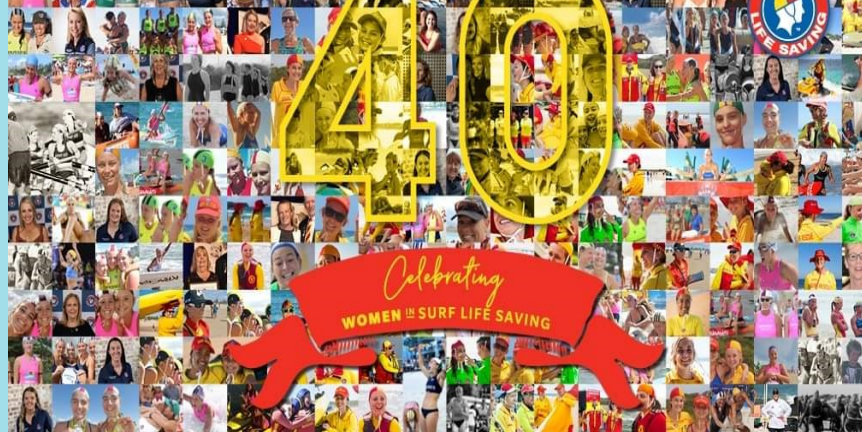

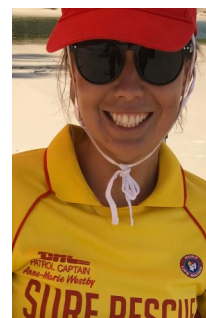

- Selected as one of two clubs to trial the new Bronze Medallion course
- Southport Masters Carnival

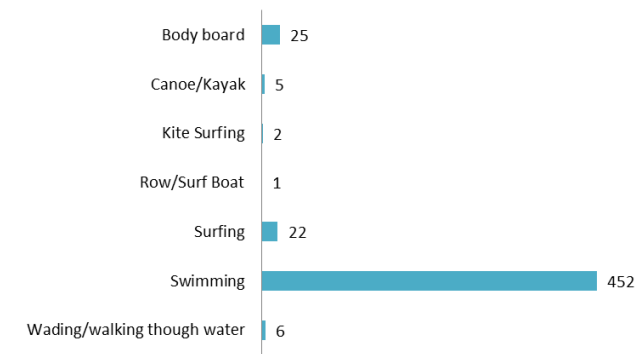
## Rescue Equipment Used



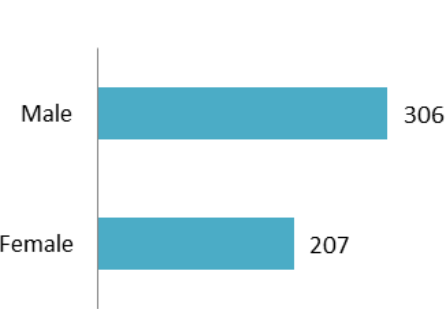
## Location of Rescue



## Activity at time of Rescue



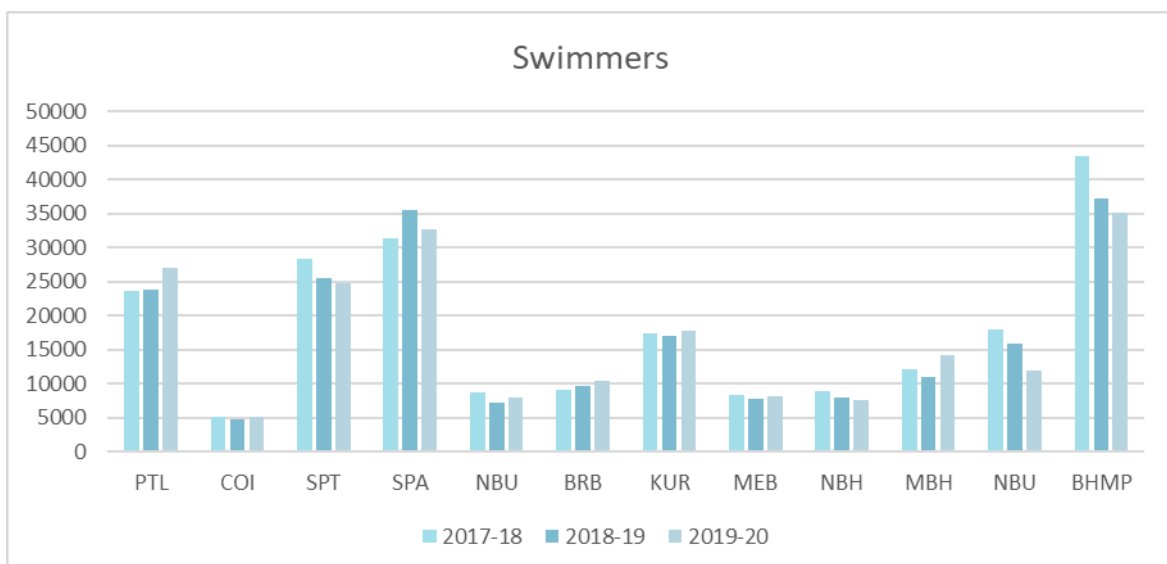
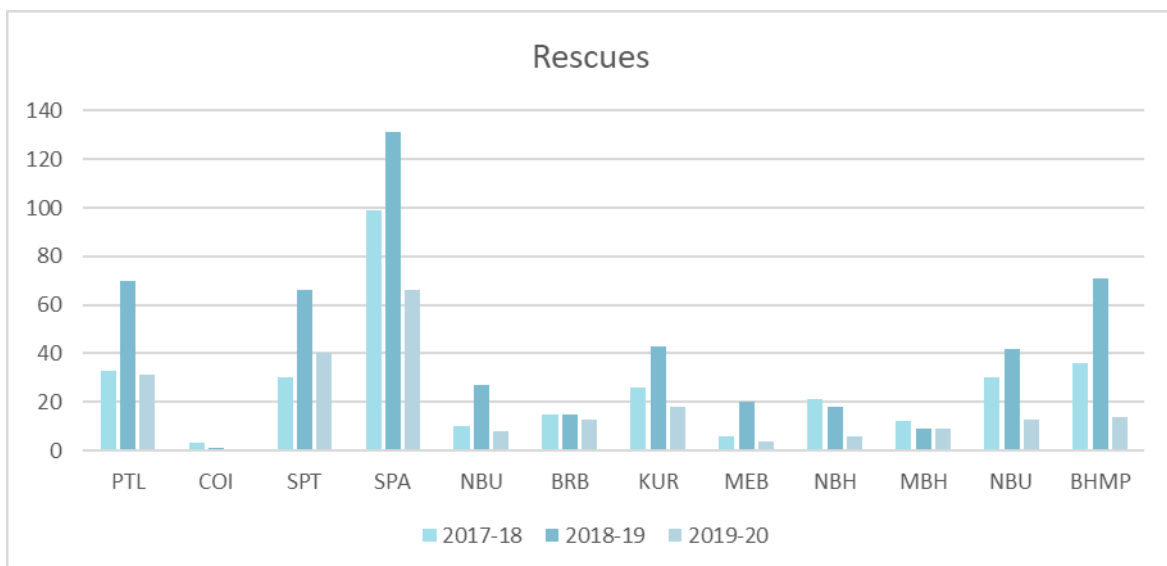
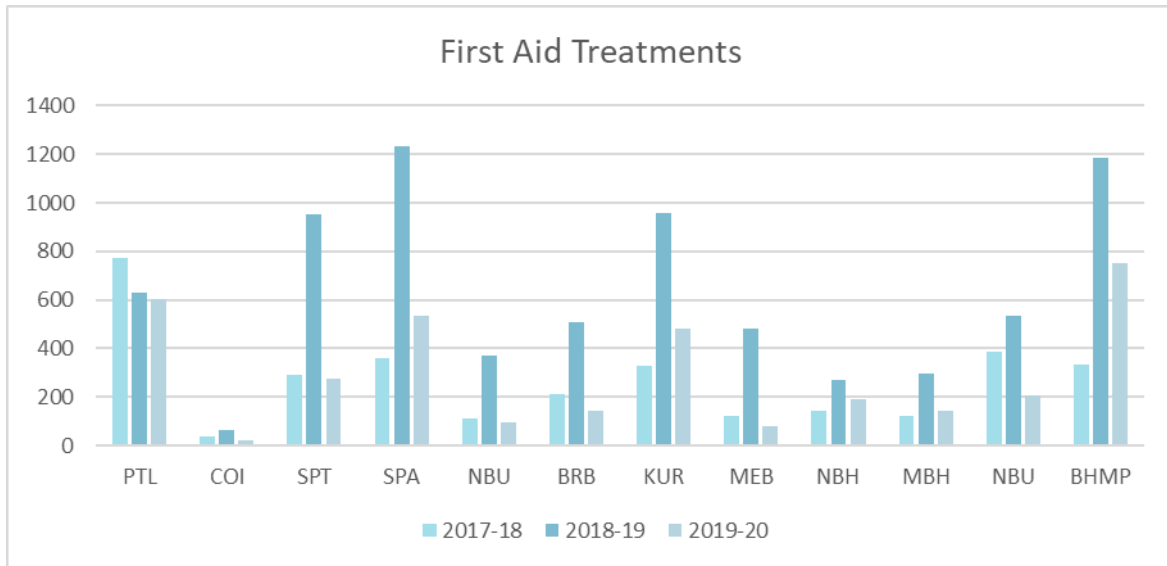

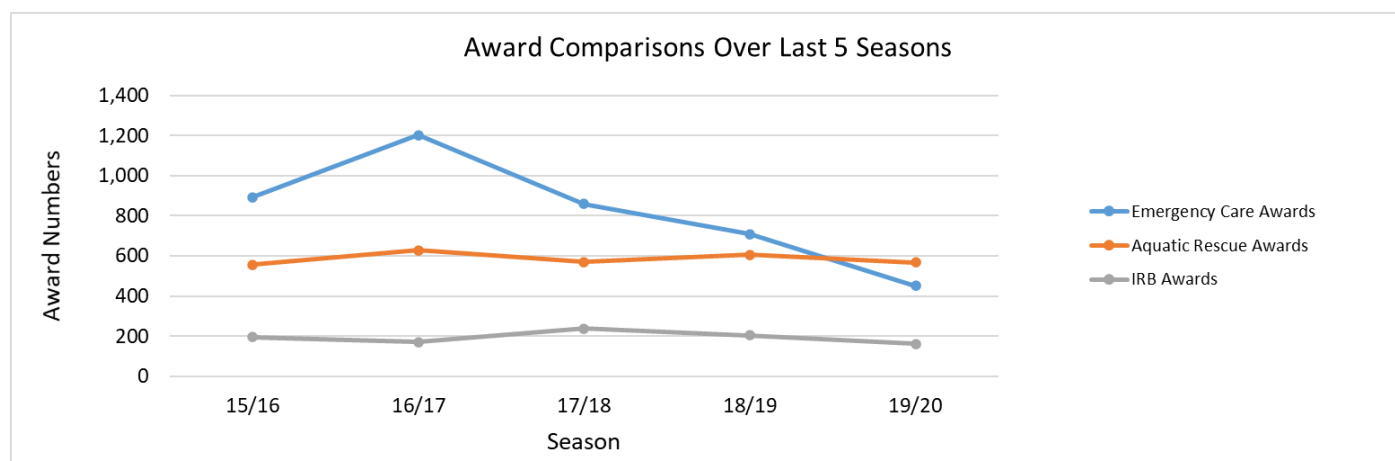
## Education Report

*Richard Morgan, Director of Education*

South Coast Branch (SCB) Trainers, Assessors and Facilitators have had a relatively quiet end to the season, with 1,476 new awards gained by Branch members, with a further 6,900 awards updated through skills maintenance sessions. The reduction of new awards is not surprising due to the decision to suspend training in March 2020, as a consequence of actions taken to combat the spread of the Covid-19 virus. Skills Maintenance numbers have increased, however, these were mostly completed before the Covid-19 Virus had entered Australia.

Although the Aquatic Rescue Awards, which includes the Bronze Medallion and Surf Rescue Certificate Awards (SRC) are tracking well, along with the IRB Awards, the Emergency Care Awards are continuing to show a year on year decline. Please see Graph 1 below: It should also be noted that during 2016/17 and 2017/18, members were required to update their Advanced Resuscitation Award, which somewhat distorts the evidence of the ongoing decline.

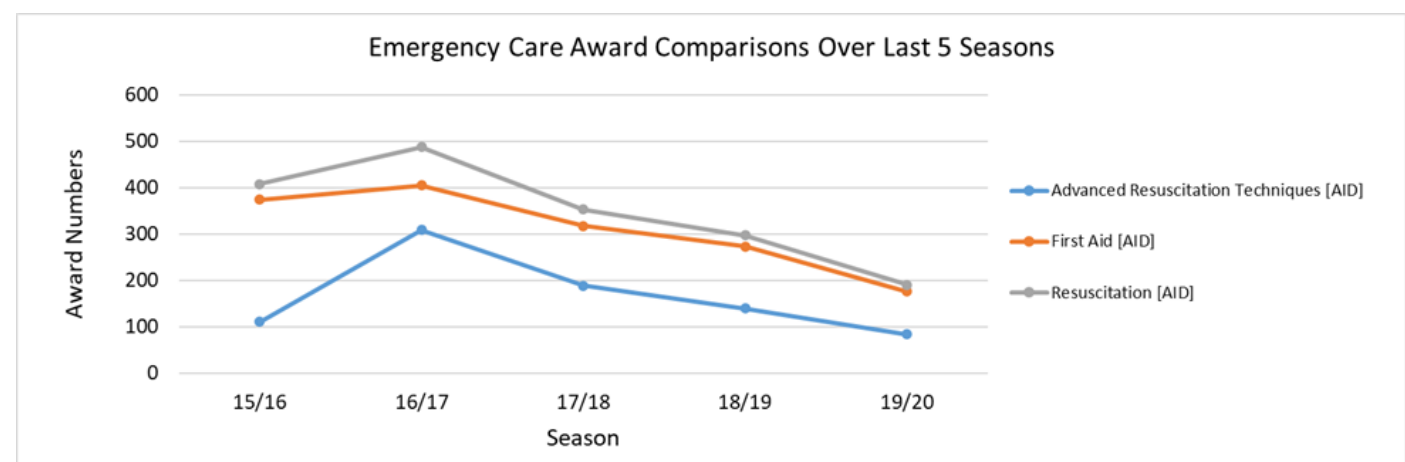

Graph 2 below provides a further breakdown of the Emergency Care Awards over the same 5 seasons and clearly demonstrates the continual decline in these Awards, which does not reflect the overall trend in the other key lifesaving Awards. Of further concern, is with the introduction of the new Bronze and SRC courses next season, delivery of oxygen therapy will be removed from these courses, and the only members eligible to deliver oxygen will be the current Advanced Resuscitation Award holders. The new SRC Award will also include the Unit of Competency HLTAID001, "Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation [CPR]", which will provide further concern on how these Emergency Care Awards will be delivered.

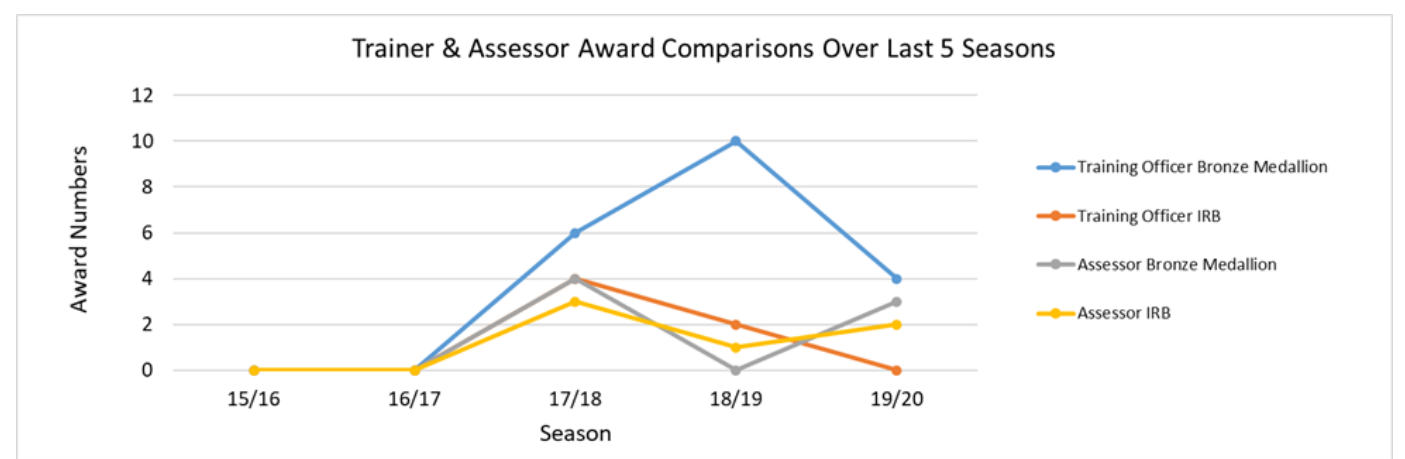

These were subsequently rank by each Club CTO, with the following key issues identified in order of highest concern:

1. Development of new Trainers & Assessors
2. Delivery of Emergency Care Emergency Care Awards
3. RTO / ALAQ Issues
4. Award Processing
5. Development and introduction of the new Pilot Bronze / SRC courses

With the downward trend of Emergency Care Awards, it is not surprising that this was ranked highly, however, there was a significant disparity between Clubs who have an ALAQ EC Facilitator compared the majority of Clubs that do not.

The area, that did feature as the greatest concern is the development of new Trainers and Assessors. Graph 3 provides a trend of new Bronze and IRB Trainers and Assessor Awards issued over the last 5 seasons. The decline began when the delivery of the Trainers Course was up-graded around 2015/16 and SLSQ opted to stop running courses until this was complete. This resulted in no Trainer courses, or Assessor courses being delivered over the two season 2015 to 2017. It should be noted that the increase in Bronze Trainers during 2018/19 was attributed to the running of some Trainer courses during the preceding season, however due to the requirement for Assessors and Facilitators to upgrade their Awards, and lack of SLSQ staff resources Training Officer courses again ceased. Thankfully, Donald Stevenson (Point Lookout CTO) and Lisa Maddison (Kurrawa CTO) both gave up two days of their annual leave and volunteered to run a Training Officer course, resulting in 9 members achieving the required Training Units of Competency. Hopefully when training start next season these members will step up and gain their Bronze and IRB Trainer Awards. I trust members will acknowledge their appreciation of both Don and Lisa when they next see them.

The final concern regarding Trainer and Assessor numbers, is there steady decline, as highlighted in Table 1 below. SCB lost 13 Bronze / IRB Trainers due these members not being proficient, and as of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019, all Assessors were required to obtain a new unit of Competency to remain proficient, "Design and Develop Assessment Tools" TAEASS502 (502). This was a relatively extensive commitment and unfortunately, SCB lost 41 Bronze / IRB Assessors. Although some of these members have since become proficient and gained their 502 Award it still highlights the ongoing concern with the declining number of Trainers and Assessors. Of particular concern is the decline in IRB Assessors, as at the end of the TAF Proficiencies, 1 Club had no IRB Assessors, 6 Clubs only had one, 4 Clubs only had 2, with only one Club having 3. This is likely to cause an issue for most Clubs in 2020/21, as during Skills Maintenance, Clubs are required to have proficient IRB Assessors to run the IRB sessions.

On a more positive note, SLSQ has now developed a new Assessors Course, and following the running of a pilot course, 1 SCB member has achieved his Assessors Units of Competency and can now look to obtaining either his Bronze or IRB Assessors Award. SCB Branch has also secured a QFES Grant to put 10 SCB Members through a course to upgrade from their Assessor Award to a full Certificate IV in Training and Assessing. It is hoped this course will enable each Club to have at least 1 Cert IV qualified member to assist with Course Supervision and to help mentor new Trainers and Assessors. In addition to the CERT IV courses, SLSQ has also developed some new Trainer and Assessor courses, which will be run through an on-line platform, blended with some face to face learning. It is also planned to develop some other courses through an on-line virtual platform.

SLSQ has also developed a new Training Operations Manual (TOM), to provide some standard guidelines for Clubs and Branches, which will help with the delivery of Education across the entire State. It is proposed that this document is presented in the same way as the Queensland Patrol Operations Manual (POM). SCB has also proposed that this document, similar to the POM, is supported by a Tri-Party Agreement between Clubs, Branch and State to create greater autonomy for Branches and Clubs, with the ability for Branches and Clubs to include specific standards adopted to support Branch and Club policies. The proposed Tri-Party agreement has been supported in principal by the SCB Executive and State Education Panel.

Finally, I would like to thank the ongoing support and efforts of the dedicated and high-quality Trainers, Assessors, Facilitators and administrative support who year on year keep on committing to the delivery of high quality Education within the Branch. I cannot express enough my appreciation for the hours of hard-work, commitment, dedication and support provided by all, many thanks.

# Junior Activities Report

*Dean Love, Director of Junior Activities*

Our junior ranks are the largest section within membership and collectively the clubs have achieved some great results this season. The relationship between the Branch and the juniors has continued in a positive nature, with regular meetings, junior information sessions (JAC Forum) and a continued focus on the Child Youth Risk Management Strategy for the development of the clubs and safety of the nippers.

The 2019/2020 season was another great season for junior membership. The branch finished with 3644 nippers overall and saw a 6% increase on the 2018/19 season. After reviewing retention rates from previous seasons a number of clubs have worked towards implementing strategies this season to retain their high nipper numbers.

Throughout the 2019/20 season a total of 3036 awards were gained by all age groups resulting in a 3.33% increase on the 2018/19 season. Of this total, 2900 nippers gained their nipper age awards and 136 U14s gained their Surf Rescue Certificates. Throughout the season all JACs have had the opportunity to provide feedback into reviewing the following season's process and resources.

Over the 2019/20 season, a total of 44 members became fully qualified age managers having now completed their Junior Activities Age Manager - Online Theory and their Junior Activities Age Manager Course. This season, 37 Junior Activities Accreditation Officer (JAAO) awards were issued; a JAAO is able to sign off on pool swims, run swim run sheets for preliminary evaluations/competition evaluations and age group awards. We would like to thank all our Age Managers, Bronze Assessors and JAAOs that assisted in supervising and signing off our Junior Activities members this season.

Despite COVID-19 affecting end of season Junior Presentations, we would like to congratulate all nippers on their efforts this season and look forward to seeing you on the beach next season.

A final thank you to all those who made Junior Activities possible this season, with the help of clubs and their volunteers the 2019/20 season was a successful one for South Coast Branch Junior Activities.

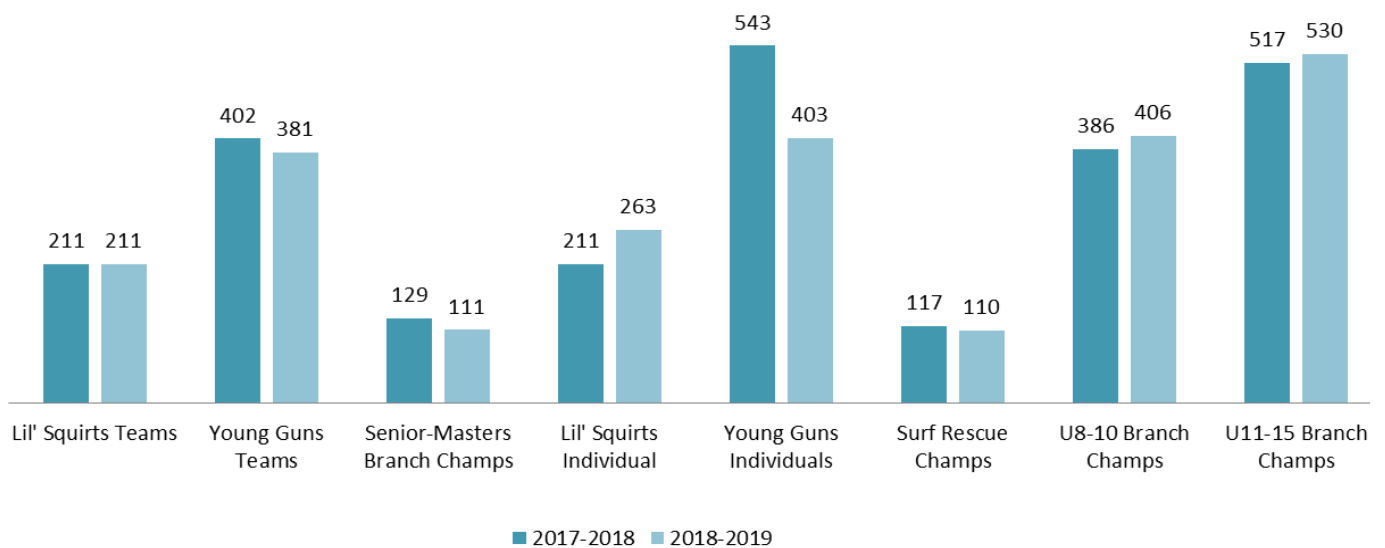

# Finance Report

*Denis Cahill, Director of Property & Finance*

It is with privilege that I present the South Coast Branch Inc Financial Report for the 2019 / 2020 Lifesaving year.

This season the continuation of the rebated affiliation fee to clubs was confirmed by the Council at its January meeting in full as a result of the strong cumulative financial position the Branch currently finds itself. As part of the current budget as approved in April 2020 it has been adopted to follow the same plan for the upcoming season with a review of the requirement for the affiliation fee to be taken at the January Council meeting although this review can be made earlier if required.

For the sixth year running the Branch has been able to pass the full amount of \$65,000 of the Gold Coast Council Grant back equally to all Gold Coast Clubs in our branch. All Gold Coast Clubs should be encouraged to acknowledge Gold Coast Council for their continued support in respect to the continuation of this Grant which helps to provide lifesaving services on the beaches of the Gold Coast. Currently we are awaiting news on this grant going forward as we have just lodged the application for the next three years.

Through the Surf sports events being run by the branch host clubs and providers of IRB's have received over \$30,000 (2019: \$21,000) (2018:\$17,000) (2017:\$24,000) (2016:\$28,000), (2015: \$18,000) which was up with the inclusion of hosting the Junior Gold Coast City Titles this season and the splitting of some of the junior carnivals. This season saw a slight increase in fees for the carnival for the U11-U14 competitors although we have managed to continue to run the U10 carnivals with a minimal charge of \$11 per competitor. Currently the budget for next years surf sports has not yet been set due to the unknown requirements of hosting a carnival in the Covid-19.

At this time we need to acknowledge and thank as a branch the continued support of the Gold Coast Council for its Annual grant of \$65,000; the Queensland Government for its support via the annual subsidies.

Finally I would like to thank the members of the Executive, Branch Councillors and Office Staff for their support and assistance throughout the past year.

#### **1. Statement of Accounting Policies**

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the *Association Incorporations Act*. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

This report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the *Associations Incorporation Act*, and the following Accounting Standards and other mandatory professional reporting requirements:

AASB 112:	Accounting for Income Tax
AASB 1031:	Materiality
AASB 110:	Events after Balance Sheet Date
AASB 117:	Leases

No other Australian Accounting Standards or authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards have been applied.

The financial report has been prepared accruals basis and is based on historic costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

#### **(b) Property Plant and Equipment**

Plant and equipment is stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Buildings are valued at fair value less accumulated depreciation. Building Improvements are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation.

The Branch Headquarters are designated as a special purpose non-residential building and net replacement value is utilised as fair value. The building was independently valued on 30 April 2004. The building has since been revalued using ABS Index 6427 – Construction of Non-Residential Buildings Queensland. This revaluation was made effective from 1 May 2010. A review of this index in May 2012 revealed that the variation in this index was -0.4%. The Committee resolved that this movement was immaterial and not to revalue the building in 2013/14. No further revaluation has been made at 30 April 2020.

Depreciation has been applied over the useful life of the assets as follows:-

13. **Investments**

On the 16<sup>th</sup> May 2004 South Coast Branch invested an amount of \$100,000 in the Surf Rescue Trust Fund administered by the Surf Lifesaving Foundation. The foundation engaged Perpetual Trustee Co Ltd as fund managers. Funds can only be withdrawn from the investment fund upon resolution of the Branch Council. This is in accordance with the initial resolution by the Branch Council and subsequent instructions given to the Trustees.

As at 30 April 2020 the balance of our account was \$192,917.97. This represents a net increase of \$838.53 after management fees of \$586 were deducted and a 0.44% return on our investment over the 12 months to 30 April 2020.
